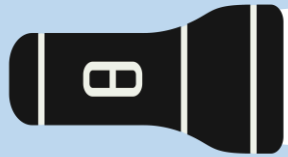
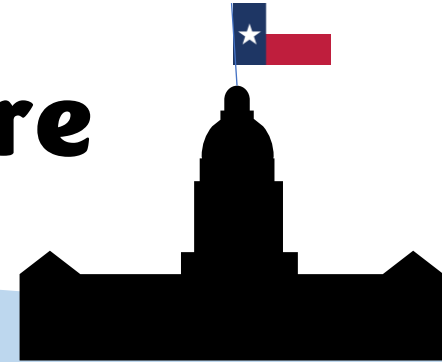

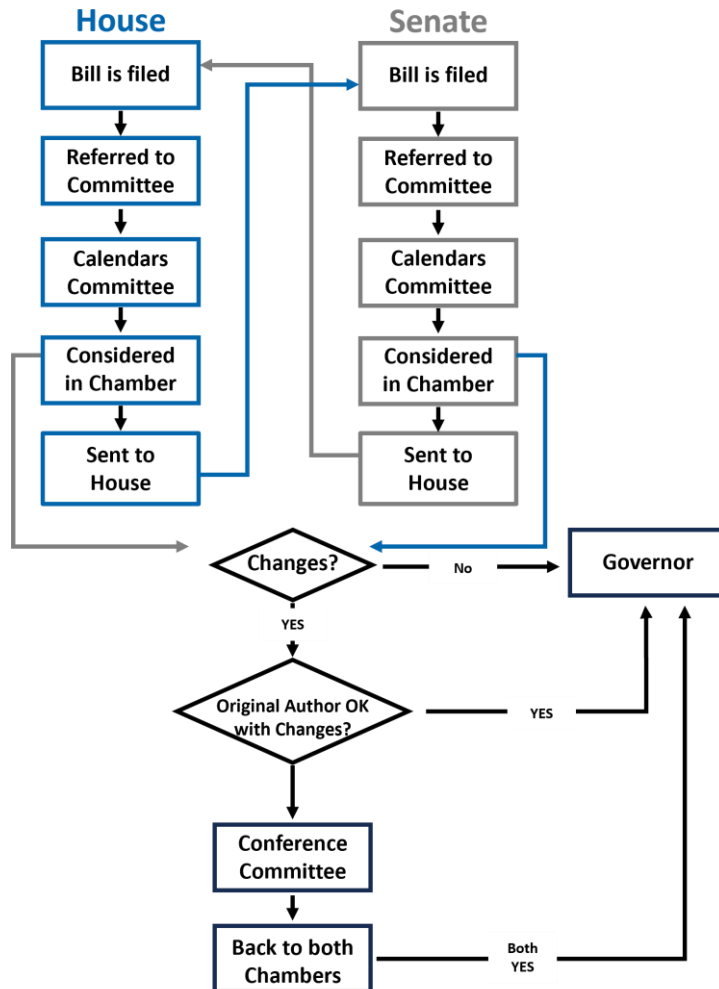

When a bill is in committee -

- Contact committee members (phone or email).
- Testify in person (at the capitol).
- Drop a card (at the capitol).
- Submit written testimony (on-line).

When a bill is headed to the floor for a vote - Contact your legislator's office via phone or email.
